### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRADE AND TRANSPORTATION CENTER IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Beginning January first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one  
2 and during the first three years from that date the Massa-  
3 chusetts Port Authority shall pay annually to the city of Boston  
4 one and one half million dollars or twenty per cent of the gross  
5 receipts from the trade and transportation center, whichever  
6 is greater, and thereafter two million dollars annually or twenty-  
7 five per cent of the gross receipts of said trade and transporta-  
8 tion center, or whichever is greater.
