## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO USE A CERTAIN PORTION OF INSTITUTE PARK IN SAID CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING THEREON A POLICE HEAD-QUARTERS BUILDING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 445 of the acts of 1967 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out, in section 2 the words "two years", and inserting  
3 in place thereof the words; — three years, — so that said second  
4 sentence shall read as follows: — In the event that construction  
5 of said police headquarters building is not commenced within  
6 three years after the effective date of this act, this act shall be  
7 come inoperative.
