## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MILFORD TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR PURCHASE OF A BUILDING TO BE LEASED TO THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth, acting by and through the  
2 superintendent of buildings, and the town of Milford may  
3 enter into an agreement for the leasing or purchasing by the  
4 commonwealth of the whole or part of a building to be con-  
5 structed or purchased by said town to provide adequate accom-  
6 modations for the branch office of the registry of motor vehicles  
7 in said town.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of  
2 any agreement that may be entered into pursuant to section one,  
3 the town of Milford may appropriate a sum of money to be  
4 provided for by taxation in the current year, by transfer from  
5 available funds, or by borrowing.

1 SECTION 3. Any sums to be borrowed under authority of this  
2 act shall not exceed in the aggregate one hundred thousand  
3 dollars and shall bear on their face the words, Town of Milford,

4 Registry of Motor Vehicles Loan, Act of 1970. Each authorized  
5 issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be  
6 paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebted-  
7 ness incurred under this act may be in excess of the statutory  
8 limit, but shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter  
9 forty-four of the General Laws exclusive of the limitation con-  
10 tained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
