## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PERMITTING PERSONS ELECTED TO THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE  
IN CITIES TO HOLD CERTAIN OTHER MUNICIPAL OFFICES AND  
POSITIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Section 32 of chapter 43 of the General Laws, as amended  
2 by chapter 318 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further amended  
3 by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following sentence:—No member of the school  
5 committee shall, while a member thereof, hold any other office  
6 or position in the school department the salary or compensation  
7 for which is payable out of the city treasury.
