1 *Ordered*, That a special committee to consist of the members
2 of the House of Representatives from Wakefield, Melrose,
3 Malden, Medford and Everett, to be designated by the speaker
4 thereof, is hereby established for the purpose of making a study
5 of the needs of the First District Court of eastern Middlesex as
6 relates to costs of any proposed renovation and expansion and
7 any other related matters. Said committee shall be provided
8 with quarters in the state house or elsewhere. Said committee
9 shall report to the general court the results of its study, and its
10 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
11 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing
12 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
13 before March sixteen, nineteen hundred and seventy.
