AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF STOCKBRIDGE TO ISSUE A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO THE RED LION INN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of
2 alcoholic beverage licenses which may be issued in the town of
3 Stockbridge under the provisions of section seventeen of chap-
4 ter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but sub-
5 ject, however, to all other provisions of said chapter, the li-
6 censing board of said town may issue a license for the sale of
7 alcoholic beverages under section twelve of said chapter one
8 hundred and thirty-eight to the Red Lion Inn in said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
