1 *Ordered*, That the Senate committee on Rules, the Senate  
2 committee on Ways and Means, the House committee on  
3 Rules, the House committee on Ways and Means, the com-  
4 mittees on Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently,  
5 and the joint committee on Ways and Means be authorized to  
6 travel and to sit, in the discharge of their duties, during the  
7 session and the recess of the General Court. The House  
8 committee on Ways and Means and the joint committee on  
9 Ways and Means shall be authorized to continue their studies  
10 of the finances of the Commonwealth and shall report their  
11 findings from time to time, but not later than June thirtieth,  
12 nineteen hundred and seventy-one, with such appropriate  
13 legislation as they may deem expedient to file with the  
14 General Court.
