## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL BIPARTISAN COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE LAWS PERTAINING TO THE CONDUCT AND OPERATION OF POLITICAL PARTIES, THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR STATE OFFICE AND THE SELECTION OF DELEGATES TO NATIONAL PARTY CONVENTIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by chapter  
2 sixty-two of the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine  
3 and revived and continued by chapter three of the resolves of  
4 nineteen hundred and seventy, shall, in the course of its in-  
5 vestigation and study consider the subject matter of current  
6 house document numbered 5016, providing for the popular elec-  
7 tion of delegates to the conventions of political parties in the  
8 commonwealth of Massachusetts.
