AN ACT DESIGNATING THE MENTAL HEALTH CENTER PRESENTLY BEING CONSTRUCTED IN THE GOVERNMENT CENTER IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE ERICH LINDEMANN MENTAL HEALTH CENTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Mental Health Center presently being constructed in
2 the Government Center in the city of Boston, shall, upon its
3 completion, be designated and known as the Erich
4 Lindemann Mental Health Center in honor of Dr. Erich
5 Lindemann, a pioneer in the development of community
6 mental health concepts and founder of the first community
7 mental health center in this country. The commissioner of
8 mental health shall cause a suitable tablet bearing said
9 designation and commemorating his pioneer efforts in com-
10 munity mental health to be erected within the said building
11 and he shall also cause suitable lettering to be placed upon
12 the outside of said building bearing said designation.
