AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE COST OF
AN EXPOSITION OR FAIR IN BOSTON HARBOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, no funds shall
2 be contributed, paid or lent by the commonwealth, its political
3 subdivisions or any body politic or corporate established by it
4 towards defraying the cost of an exposition or fair which may
5 be held in Boston Harbor within ten years from the effective
6 date of this act.
