Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. Bliss of North Attleborough, for a Bill requiring in-service and supervisory training for fire fighters (House, No. 487). March 24.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on public safety be autho-
2 rized to sit during the recess of the general court for the pur-
3 pose of making an investigation and study of the subject
4 matter of current house document numbered 487, requiring
5 in-service and supervisory training for firefighters.

6 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the
7 state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel
8 within the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and
9 other services and for expenses such sums as may be appro-
10 priated therefor.

11 Said committee shall report to the general court the re-
12 sults of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
13 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
14 such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the
15 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last
16 Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and seventy.
