AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CLUB LICENSE TO WOMEN'S CITY CLUB OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of licenses
2 which may be granted under section seventeen of chapter one
3 hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws but subject,
4 however, to all other provisions of said chapter, the licensing
5 board for the city of Boston may grant to the Women's City Club
6 of Boston an annual club license to sell all alcoholic beverages, to
7 be drunk on its premises at nos. 39 and 40 Beacon Street in said
8 city, to its members and to guests introduced by such members
9 and to no others. Such license shall not be transferable to any
10 other licensee.
