AN ACT DESIGNATING CERTAIN PERSONS AS MEMBERS, EX OFFICIIS, OF REPRESENTATIVE TOWN MEETINGS HELD IN THE TOWN OF ADAMS AND REQUIRING CERTAIN OTHER PERSONS TO ATTEND SUCH HEARINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 235 of the acts of 1935 is hereby 2 amended by striking out the first sentence thereof and inserting

5 as otherwise provided herein, shall be limited to the voters elected 6 under section two, together with the following, designated as
