AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE TRUSTEES OF TUFTS COLLEGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 141 of the acts of 1852 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the word "thirty", inserted
3 by section 1 of chapter 42 of the acts of 1878, and inserting in
4 place thereof the word:—thirty-one.

1 SECTION 2. Twenty of the members of the trustees of Tufts
2 college, incorporated by chapter one hundred and forty-one
3 of the acts of eighteen hundred and fifty-two under the name
4 of the trustees of the Tufts college, and whose name was
5 changed to its present one by section one of chapter seventy-
6 two of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, herein-
7 after called the corporation, shall be elected by the members
8 of the corporation then serving in office. Ten of the members
9 of the corporation shall be elected from among the alumni of
10 the corporation's colleges and schools either by the alumni
11 acting directly as a whole or by such representatives of the
12 alumni as may be chosen members of a representative group.
13 The president of the corporation shall be a member of the
14 corporation, ex officio, during the term of his office as
15 president. Members of the corporation in office on the effec-
16 tive date of this act, other than alumni members, shall
17 continue in office without limit of time and alumni members
18 then in office shall continue in office until the expiration of
19 the terms to which they were elected. Except as herein stated,
20 the qualifications, terms of office, and the manner of election

21 of the members of the corporation shall be as specified from
22 time to time in the by-laws of the corporation.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the acts
2 of nineteen hundred and thirty-four, and all other acts and
3 parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall not take effect until it shall have
2 been accepted by vote of the trustees of Tufts college and a
3 copy of the vote of acceptance shall have been filed with the
4 secretary of the commonwealth.
