AN ACT CONCERNING THE PUNISHMENT OF PERSONS WHO INTERFERE WITH FIRE AND POLICE SIGNAL SYSTEMS OR EITHER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32 of chapter 268 of the General Laws, as appear-
2 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out, in line 9, the words "shall be punished by a fine of
4 not" and inserting in place thereof the words:—shall be
5 punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor.
