AN ACT REQUIRING EVERY CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC BUILDING CONSTRUCTION TO INCLUDE SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF WEATHER PROTECTION AND HEATING DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 44C of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 The specifications for every contract subject to section
- 4 forty-four A shall include details for the installation of weather
- 5 protection, shall require that the general contractor shall install
- 6 the same and that he shall furnish adequate heat in the area so
- 7 protected during the months of November through March.
