## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

### AN ACT PROHIBITING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FROM TRANSFERRING CERTAIN LANDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 The Metropolitan District Commission shall be prohibited
- 2 from transferring in any manner for any purpose including
- 3 care, custody or control, any land owned by it and situated
- 4 in the Stony Brook Reservation of the Roslindale-Hyde Park
- 5 districts of the city of Boston.
