AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO AMEND ARTICLE II OF THE SANITARY CODE SO AS NOT TO APPLY TO ANY SINGLE DWELLING WHICH IS OCCUPIED BY THE OWNER THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public health is hereby directed to amend
- 2 Article II of the sanitary code, making it inapplicable to single
- 3 dwellings occupied by the owner thereof.
