1 *Ordered*, That the joint standing committee on urban affairs
2 be authorized to sit during recess to study and investigate the
3 subject matter of current house document numbered 1164.
4 Said joint standing committee shall have the power to summon
5 witnesses, subpoena records relevant to its investigation, and
6 to hire research, legal, and clerical employees. Said committee
7 shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation
8 and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts
9 of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into
10 effect, by filing the same with the House clerk on or before the
11 last Wednesday of December 1970.
