1 *Ordered*, That the joint standing committee on urban affairs be  
2 authorized to sit during recess to study and investigate the subject  
3 matter of current house document 3979, 2640, and 5263  
4 appendix E. Said joint standing committee shall have the power  
5 to summon witnesses, subpoena records relevant to its investi-  
6 gation, and to hire research, legal, and clerical employees. Said  
7 committee shall report to the General Court the results of its  
8 investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together  
9 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommen-  
10 dations into effect, by filing the same with the House clerk on or  
11 before the last Wednesday of December, 1970.
