RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE FEASIBILITY OF REQUIRING SPECIAL TYPE BUSES IN TRANSPORTING RETARDED CHILDREN TO AND FROM SCHOOL.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of represent-
3 atives, the registrar of motor vehicles or his designee, the
4 commissioner of education or his designee, and two persons to be
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose
6 of making an investigation and study of the types of transporta-
7 tion provided for retarded children when transporting them to
8 and from school, the feasibility of requiring special type buses for
9 such purpose, and all other matters relative thereto which the
10 commission deems reasonable and proper.
