AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM WAGES FOR AGRICULTURAL WORKERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

Section 2A of chapter 151 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words "one dollar and fifty cents", inserted by section 8 of chapter 718 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the words: — one dollar and sixty cents.
