AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE TO REIMBURSE WARREN GREENFIELD OF ABINGTON FOR MONIES LOST BY HIM WHILE AIDING IN A CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF SAID TOWN OF BRAINTREE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the town of
- 2 Braintree is hereby authorized to pay to Warren Greenfield,
- 3 233 Ashland Street, Abington, from available funds in its
- 4 treasury, the sum of ninety-nine dollars as reimbursement for
- 5 monies lost by him while aiding in a criminal investigation
- 6 conducted by the police department of said town of Braintree.
