AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO OFFER FREE TRANSFER PRIVILEGE TO QUALIFIED PUPILS AND CHILDREN FOR A FARE OF FIFTEEN CENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, school chil-
2 dren, as defined and to the extent set forth in the fare schedule of
3 the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, hereinafter
4 referred to as the Authority, relating to their transportation on
5 lines formerly operated by the Metropolitan Transit Authority to
6 and from school houses in which they attend schools and their
7 homes, and children between the ages of five and eleven years
8 inclusive shall be transported by the Authority for a fare at the
9 rate of fifteen cents, with free transfer privileges, so as to afford a
10 continuous journey in any direction except for return to point of
11 origin and without stopover.
