The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY OF A HIGH SPEED MONO-RAIL SYSTEM CONNECTING THE CITIES OF WORCESTER AND SPRINGFIELD WITH THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, one of whom shall be from Suffolk
3 county and two of whom shall be from Worcester county,
4 five members of the house of representative, two of whom
5 shall be from Suffolk county and three of whom shall be
6 from Worcester county, and the members of the Massachu-
7 setts Turnpike Authority, is hereby established for the pur-
8 pose of making an investigation and study relative to the
9 advisability and feasibility of the construction by said
10 Authority of a high speed mono-rail connecting the cities of
11 Worcester and Springfield with the city of Boston.

12 A sum not to exceed one hundred and fifty thousand dollars
13 —for purposes of said study, to be paid by the Massachusetts
14 Turnpike Authority.
