By Mr. Aguiar of Swansea, petition of Robert A. Boucher and others (members of the board of selectmen) and Antone S. Aguiar, Jr. (by vote of the town) for legislation to validate action taken by the town of Swansea in granting retroactive pay raises to certain employees of said town and in appropriating certain funds for retroactive payments. AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTION OF THE TOWN OF SWANSEA IN GRANTING RETROACTIVE PAY RAISES TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF SAID TOWN AND IN APPROPRIATING A CERTAIN SUM FOR RETROACTIVE PAYMENTS UNDER ONE OF THE AGREEMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the
2 contrary, the Town of Swansea, at a special town meeting called
3 for that purpose, may approve a labor agreement by and between
4 said town and the American Federation of State, County, and
5 Municipal Employees, for all permanent full-time police depart-
6 ment employees of said town granting them certain wage and
7 fringe benefits retroactive to January first, nineteen hundred and
8 seventy, and may appropriate from available funds the sum of
9 three thousand five hundred dollars to carry out the terms of said
10 contract.

1 SECTION 2. Any action taken by the Town of Swansea at the
2 special town meeting held on July thirteenth, nineteen hundred
3 and seventy, shall be as valid and effective as though section one
4 of this act had been in full force and effect at the time of the
5 posting of the warrant for said meeting.
