The House committee on Rules, to whom was referred the Order relative to the appointment of a special committee of the House to make an investigation and study of the veterans' preference law and other related matters (House, No. 5976), report that the same ought to be adopted in the form of a substitute order herewith submitted (House, No. 6023).

1 *Ordered*, That a special committee, to consist of two members
2 of the senate to be designated by the president thereof, and five
3 members of the house of representatives to be designated by the
4 speaker thereof, is hereby established for the purpose of making
5 an investigation and study of the Veterans' Preference Law, so
6 called, and any other related matters, with particular reference to
7 the subject matter of current house document numbered 2425,
8 to be known as the veterans' preference act of nineteen hundred
9 and seventy, and may sit during the recess of the general court.
10 Said committee, in the course of its investigation and study, shall
11 consult with representatives of nationally chartered veterans'
12 organizations.

13 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
14 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within and
15 without the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and
16 other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated
17 therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court the
18 results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if
19 any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
20 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
21 the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of
22 December, nineteen hundred and seventy.
