AN ACT INCREASING THE SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS REHABILITATION COMMISSION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in section 77 by adding after item 9, as inserted by
3 section 1 of chapter 328 of the acts of 1959, the following new
4 item:—

5 10. Services to the families of a handicapped individual when
6 such services are necessary towards the rehabilitation of such
7 individual.

1 SECTION 2. Section 78 of said chapter 6, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 486 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out in line eight the figure “9” and inserting
4 in place thereof the figure:— “10”.
