## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF READING TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICIALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one  
2 hundred and eight of chapter forty-one of the General Laws or  
3 any other provision of law to the contrary, the town of Reading  
4 may, by vote of the town at a special town meeting, rescind or  
5 revoke the action taken at the annual town meeting held in the  
6 current year fixing the salaries of the board of assessors and ap-  
7 propriating the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars for  
8 the payment of such salaries, and may fix the salary of the  
9 chairman of said board of assessors at four thousand two hun-  
10 dred dollars, of the secretary of said board at one thousand  
11 eight hundred dollars and of the third member of said board at  
12 one thousand four hundred dollars, and may further appropriate  
13 the sum of seven thousand four hundred dollars of which sum  
14 four thousand five hundred dollars is to be raised in the tax  
15 levy of the current year and of which sum two thousand nine  
16 hundred dollars is to be transferred from surplus revenue, as if  
17 the said action had been taken at the annual town meeting.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
