AN ACT RELATING TO THE REIMBURSEMENT TO COMMUNITIES PAID TO TEACHERS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 46E of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in Chapter 70B of the acts of 1962, is hereby
3 amended by adding to Line 3 after the words—"Section
4 46"—the following: — sections forty-six A, forty-six H and
5 sections thirty-two and thirty-three of chapter sixty-nine of the
6 General Laws.
