AN ACT RELATIVE TO A STUDY TO DETERMINE PROGRAMMING AND PHYSICAL NEEDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RESIDENTIAL CENTER FOR EMOTIONALLY DISTURBED CHILDREN WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be appropriated the sum of \$84,260
2 (Eighty-four Thousand, Two Hundred and Sixty Dollars) for
3 the purposes of conducting a study to determine programming
4 and physical needs for establishment of a residential center for
5 emotionally disturbed children in the Commonwealth. Such
6 study shall be conducted under the direction of the Special
7 Commission Established to Make a Study and Investigation
8 Relative to Facilities for the Handicapped and shall be
9 completed within a twelve month period following the
10 authorization of such funds.
