## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TREASURER OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO PAY CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the county  
2 treasurer of Middlesex county is hereby authorized to pay,  
3 subject to appropriation, to Arnold Graphic Industries Inc.  
4 for two unpaid bills a total sum of one thousand five hundred  
5 and fifty-eight dollars and fifteen cents, one for thirty thou-  
6 sand parking violation tag forms delivered in nineteen hun-  
7 dred and sixty-six and one for twenty-five thousand such  
8 forms delivered in nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, and to  
9 pay to Callaghan & Company for two law books delivered in  
10 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven the total sum of forty-six  
11 dollars.
