RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATING CHARLES E. SHEPARD ON HIS APPOINTMENT AS COMMISSIONER OF ADMINISTRATION.

1 *Whereas*, On August 12, 1970 Charles E. Shepard was
2 sworn in as Commissioner of Administration, thereby culmi-
3 nating thirty years of devoted public service most of which
4 dealt with the administration of the finances of the com-
5 monwealth; and

6 *Whereas*, Charles E. Shepard, or "Charlie" as he has be-
7 come affectionately known to the thousands of public officials
8 both state and local with whom he came in contact during
9 this time, first entered public service as a representative from
10 the Fourth Worcester District and served that area from
11 1941 through 1946; and

12 *Whereas*, In 1947, Charlie was appointed budget director
13 of the House Committee on Ways and Means and served in
14 that capacity until 1965 when he was appointed deputy com-
15 missioner of fiscal affairs, in 1967 he was appointed temporary
16 director of personnel and standardization and in 1968 he was
17 appointed first deputy commissioner which position he held
18 until his appointment as commissioner; and

19 *Whereas*, During his long career in public service, Charlie
20 Shepard distinguished himself as a public employee, ever
21 conscious of his obligation to his position and won the respect
22 and admiration of everyone with whom he came in contact;
23 and

24 *Whereas*, His accomplishments and devotion to duty re-
25 flect credit on his family, his native town of Warren and the
26 Commonwealth; therefore be it

27 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives
28 hereby extends to Charles E. Shepard its congratulations on
29 his appointment as Commissioner of Administration and its
30 best wishes for good health and continued success in all his
31 future activities; and be it further

32 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded
33 by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to Charles E. Shepard.
