RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO DIRECT THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY TO DOUBLE THE FOSTER GRANDPARENTS PROGRAM.

Whereas, The foster grandparents program has been so successful in providing the means whereby older persons may demonstrate their love for mentally retarded and disturbed children throughout the nation; and

Whereas, The facilities and funds necessary to fulfill the needs of said program have proven inadequate; now therefore be it

Resolved, That the General Court of Massachusetts respectfully urges the Congress of the United States to enact legislation directing the office of economic opportunity to double the foster grandparents program; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be transmitted forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to the President of the United States, to the presiding officer of each branch of the Congress, and to the members thereof from the commonwealth.
