AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF QUINCY TO ALLOW AN ANNUITY TO MRS. MARY WOOD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Charles R. Wood, a veteran and an employee
2 of the City of Quincy for more than thirty-four years, was
3 pensioned in accordance with Chapter 32, Section 58, of the
4 General Laws on February 11, 1957, without being informed
5 of his rights under a new law — Chapter 32, Section 58-B —
6 effective October 23, 1956, which gave him the option to pro-
7 vide for his surviving spouse.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to
2 the contrary, an annuity in the amount of \$521.90 per year,
3 under Chapter 670 of the Acts of 1960, shall be established for
4 his widow, MARY WOOD, as long as she should live.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the City of Quincy.
