AN ACT AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY REGISTRATION AS QUALIFIED PHYSICIANS UNDER DESIGNATED CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by 2 adding after section 9A the following section: —

3 Section 9B. Temporary registration as a qualified physician

4 may be granted (1) to a visiting physician holding a license 5 to practice in another state or territory or in the District of

6 Columbia or in another country and having a temporary facul

6 Columbia or in another country and having a temporary facul-7 ty appointment certified by the dean of a medical school in the

8 Commonwealth for purposes of medical education in an ac-

9 credited hospital associated with the medical school, such reg-

10 istration to terminate automatically upon termination of the

11 faculty appointment and, in any event, at the end of eight

12 months; (2) to a physician holding a license to practice in

13 another state or territory or in the District of Columbia to

14 permit him to act as a *locum tenens* for a registered physician

15 in the Commonwealth, to be granted only upon written re-

16 quest of this physician and to be limited to three months or

17 less; (3) to a physician eligible for examination or registra-

18 tion in the Commonwealth who is a diplomate of a specialty

19 board approved by the American Medical Association or the

20 American Osteopathic Association to permit him to act as

21 locum tenens for a registered physician in the Commonwealth,

22 to be granted only upon written request of this physician, to

23 be limited to the specialty in which the applicant is certified

24 and to be limited to three months or less.
