AN ACT TO PROVIDE REMEDIAL INSTRUCTION FOR CHILDREN WITH PERCEPTUAL-MOTOR HANDICAPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 10 "shall".
