AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR HALF THE COST OF INNOVATIVE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND SUPPLEMENTARY EDUCATION CENTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 47A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 47B.* The state department of education shall re-
- 4 imburse any city or town for one half the cost of the estab-
- 5 lishment of a supplementary education center or innovative
- 6 educational programs, as authorized under section four A of
- 7 chapter forty, upon determination by the department that
- 8 said center or program meets standards established by the
- 9 department.

- 6 educational program, as authorized under section 27A of
- 7 chapter 11B, upon determination by the department that
- 8 said center or program meets standards established by the
- 9 department.
