AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS AT STATE COLLEGES BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE STATE COLLEGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 73 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding at the end of the following section: —
- 3 *Section 19.* The board shall grant certain scholarships an-
- 4 nually in number equal to two per cent of the preceding Sep-
- 5 tember full-time day student enrollment to worthy students
- 6 who are residents of the commonwealth and who possess the
- 7 requisite ability and who are in need of financial assistance.
- 8 The board shall establish at each state college a scholarship
- 9 committee consisting of the academic dean, the dean of ad-
- 10 missions, and the registrar of the college to select the recipi-
- 11 ents of the scholarships available.
