AN ACT TO ADJUST SALARIES IN THE DIVISION OF
STATE COLLEGE OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 16 of Chapter 73 of the General Laws 5th para-
2 graph second sentence after the words shown in said schedule;
3 the words as appearing: "however, that the trustees may
4 establish the salary for the president," is deleted and sub-
5 stituted therefor is the following: — "however, that the
6 trustees may establish the salary for the Director of the Divi-
7 sion of State Colleges, and for the president."

As it is intended by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
 Court assembled, and by the majority of the same, as follows:

Section 18 of Chapter 13 of the District Laws of 1854
 which passed and the words therein are as follows:—
 "The words as appearing" however, that the President may
 establish the same for the President, it is held and sub-
 stituted thereon in the following:— "however, that the
 President may establish the same for the President of the Dis-
 trict of Columbia, and for the President."
