AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR A SECOND CONVICTION OF
THE CRIME OF UNLAWFUL USE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 24 of chapter
2 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, in line
3 24, as appearing in chapter 316 of the acts of 1966, after the
4 words "both" the words: — ; provided, however, that in the
5 case of a second conviction therefor, punishment of imprison-
6 ment shall be required for a term of not less than thirty days
7 and the imposition or execution of said sentence shall not be
8 suspended.

By Mr. CANNON, a motion was made to amend the bill so as to read as follows: "and to provide for a certain number of copies of the same to be printed for the use of the Senate."

The Amendments of the Bill

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A CERTAIN NUMBER OF COPIES OF THE REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, and by the authority of the Senate, as follows:

1. Paragraph (a) of subsection 123 of section 24 of chapter 100 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting in line 23, as appearing in chapter 100 of the acts of 1915 after the words "and", the words --, provided however, that in the case of a second edition thereof (including of subsequent editions) the number of copies shall be reduced to one less than thirty days and the provision of subsection of said section shall not be applicable.
