AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF A CEMETERY FOR THE MAKING OF
A COMMERCIAL FILM WITHOUT PERMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 114 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 42 the following section:—

3 *Section 42A.* No person shall use the premises of a ceme-
4 tery or burial place for the purpose of making a film for com-
5 mercial purposes, without the previous consent of the mayor
6 or the board of selectmen of the city or town in which such
7 cemetery or burial place is located. Whoever violates the pro-
8 visions of this section shall be punished by imprisonment for
9 not more than six months or by a fine of not more than one
10 thousand dollars.
