The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MILITARY TRAINING OF THE NATIONAL
GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 33, Section 15 (b) is hereby amended by striking
2 out the last sentence and inserting the following: — “Except
3 as otherwise provided, he may enter into service and main-
4 tenance agreements with agencies of the United States govern-
5 ment for the construction, use and operation of installations
6 to facilitate the training of active and reserve forces of the
7 United States including the National Guard Army and Air;
8 and he shall require that all contracts and may require that
9 all expenditures made by the division be submitted to him for
10 approval”.
