AN ACT HAVING TO DO WITH THE FISCAL AFFAIRS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The General Laws, chapter 30, section 45, subsection 5, is  
2 hereby amended by adding thereto, after clause (d), the fol-  
3 lowing clause: —

4 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions of clause (d) above,  
5 the Director of Personnel and Standardization may authorize  
6 as permanent offices and positions those offices and positions  
7 which were temporarily allocated or reallocated under exist-  
8 ing laws, rules or regulations in any totally federally funded  
9 agency the appropriations for which are not included in any  
10 appropriation act enacted by the General Court.

 2 hereby amended by adding therein after clause (c), the fol-  
 3 lowing clause:—

4 (d) Notwithstanding the provisions of clause (d) above,  
 5 the Director of Personnel and Standardization may authorize  
 6 as permanent officers and positions those officers and positions  
 7 which were temporarily allocated or re-allocated under exist-  
 8 ing laws, rules or regulations in any fiscal year fully ended  
 9 except the appropriation for which are not included in any  
 10 appropriation act enacted by the General Court.
