AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVELING EXPENSES OF A SPECIAL JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURTS WHEN SITTING IN A COURT OTHER THAN THE COURT TO WHICH HE WAS APPOINTED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 81 of chapter 218 of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting in the first full  
3 line of the first sentence thereof, as it appears in section 17  
4 of chapter 810 of the acts of 1963, after the words "A justice",  
5 the following: — , or a special justice.
