AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE SOLID WASTE
DISPOSAL POWERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter sixteen of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence of section twenty-
3 two and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
4 The Department, at least sixty days prior to submitting its
5 estimates as required by section four of chapter twenty-nine,
6 shall annually submit for approval, by certified mail, to each
7 city and town a proposed operation and capital budget indi-
8 cating the projected costs, projected revenues and a schedule
9 of user rates of the disposal of solid wastes originating within
10 such cities and towns. Within thirty days after such sub-
11 mission, said cities and towns shall disapprove or approve the
12 budget as submitted or subject to such itemized reductions
13 therein as the cities and towns shall deem appropriate.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter sixteen of the General Laws is hereby
2 further amended by inserting after the word "department", as
3 appearing in the second sentence of section twenty-four, the
4 following clause: — , subject to the approval of the cities and
5 towns, —.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter sixteen of the General Laws is hereby
2 further amended by inserting after the word "hearing", as
3 appearing in the third sentence of section twenty-four, the

4 following clause: — and subject to the approval of the cities
5 and towns, —.

1 SECTION 4. Section two of Chapter eight hundred thirty-
2 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "governor", as first ap-
4 pearing in the first sentence thereof, the following clause: —
5 with the approval of the cities and towns, —.
