1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral ob-  
 2 ligation of the commonwealth, and subject to appropriation,  
 3 there shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to the  
 4 following named persons the amounts of money set opposite  
 5 their names for damages suffered by them as a result of the  
 6 order of the division of natural resources, acting through its  
 7 division of forests and parks, ordering them to remove certain  
 8 buildings owned by them in the Myles Standish Reservation on
