By Mr. Wall, a petition of Thomas J. Lane that provision be made for the payment from the treasury of the Commonwealth of a sum of money to Arline Feugill for injuries sustained as the result of a fall at the bus shelter at the Tewksbury State Hospital. Ways and Means (Joint).

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF ARLINE FEUGILL.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral ob-
2 ligation of the commonwealth and subject to appropriation,
3 there shall be paid from the state treasury the sum of
4 dollars to Arline Feugill of Methuen for personal injuries
5 caused by a fall due to a defective condition in the bus shelter
6 at the Tewksbury State Hospital, under the control of the de-
7 partment of public health, on April twenty-ninth, nineteen
8 hundred and sixty-seven. No payment shall be made here-
9 under until there is filed with the comptroller an agreement
10 signed by Arline Feugill that the amount, if any, paid or to
11 be paid for legal services in connection with the passage of
12 this resolve shall not exceed ten percent of this sum.
