The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT CERTAIN TIDEGATES AND CULVERTS IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Metropolitan District Commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct one or more tidegates and necessary
3 culverts at the outlets of the drainage area located below and
4 adjacent to Quincy Shore Drive in the vicinity of Carlisle
5 Street, Bay State Road, North Street and Commander Shea
6 Boulevard in the city of Quincy for the purpose of alleviating
7 serious flooding conditions. For said purpose said commission
8 may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
