The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE VOIDING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE CONTRACTS OF SALE BY THE BUYER IF SAID MOTOR VEHICLE CANNOT PASS THE INSPECTION STICKER TEST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 7M the following section:—
3 *Section 7N.* Notwithstanding any disclaimer of warranty
4 a motor vehicle contract of sale may be voided by the buyer
5 if the motor vehicle fails to pass the inspection sticker test
6 within seven days from the date of sale at an inspection
7 station selected by the buyer pursuant to section seven A;
8 provided that the reason for failure to issue the sticker was
9 not caused by the buyer's negligent operation of the motor
10 vehicle; provided further that the repair costs necessary be-
11 fore the inspection sticker will be granted exceed ten per-
12 cent of the purchase price of the motor vehicle.

13 In order to void a motor vehicle contract of sale under this
14 section the buyer shall notify the seller of his intention to
15 void the contract and shall deliver the motor vehicle to the
16 seller within three days following receipt by the buyer of a
17 written statement with respect to such failure to receive an
18 inspection sticker and at such time the buyer shall also de-
19 liver to the seller an estimate of the repair costs. This section
20 shall apply only to motor vehicles intended for immediate
21 personal or family use.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first,
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-one and shall apply to motor
3 vehicle contracts of sale entered into on and after said date.
